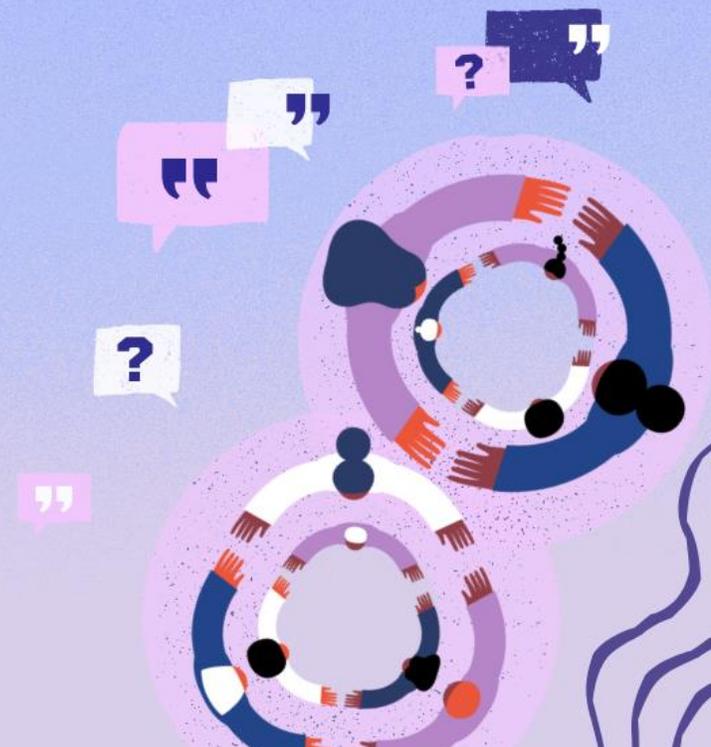

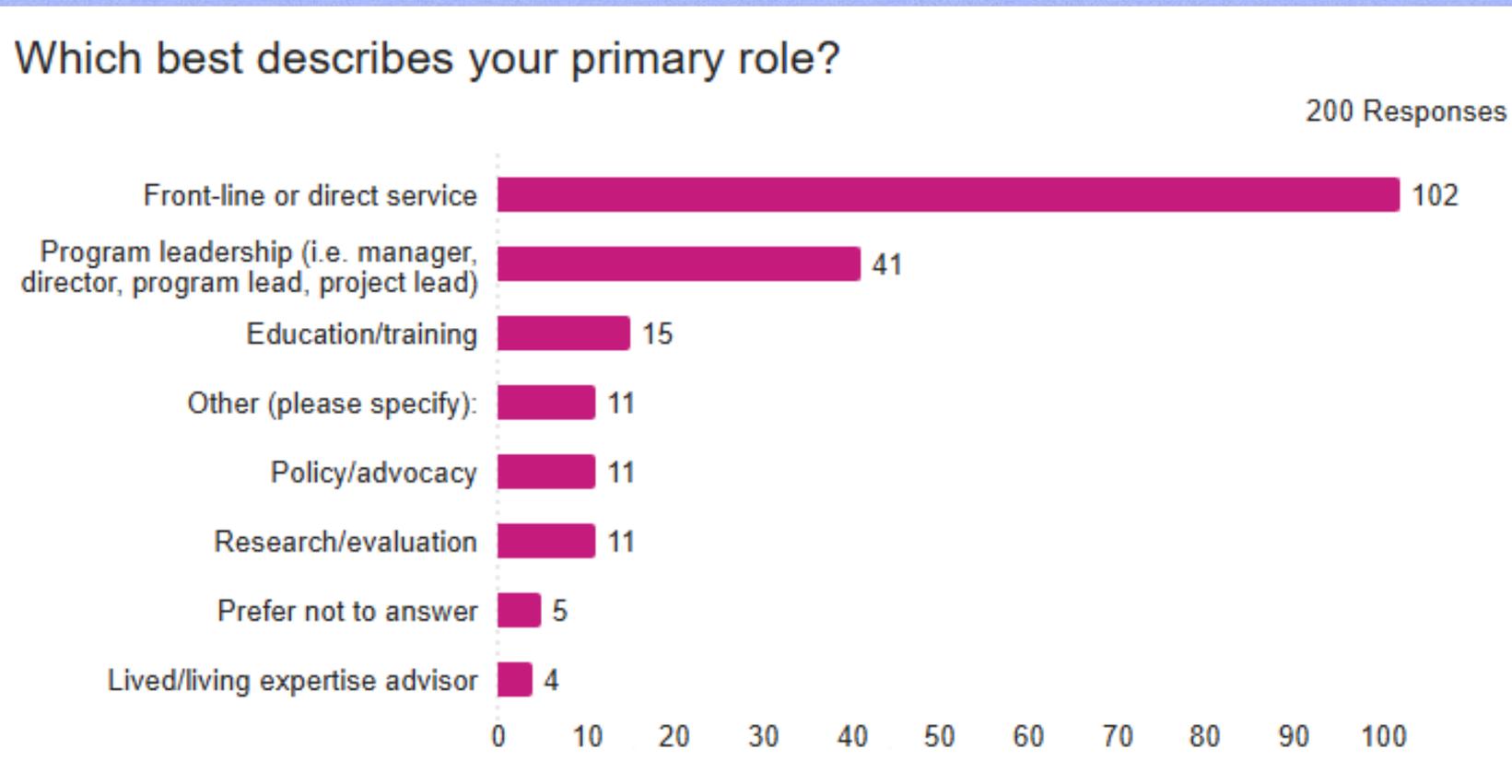
Where is AI showing up in GBV-related work?

Where do you see potential future uses of AI in GBV-related work (if at all)?

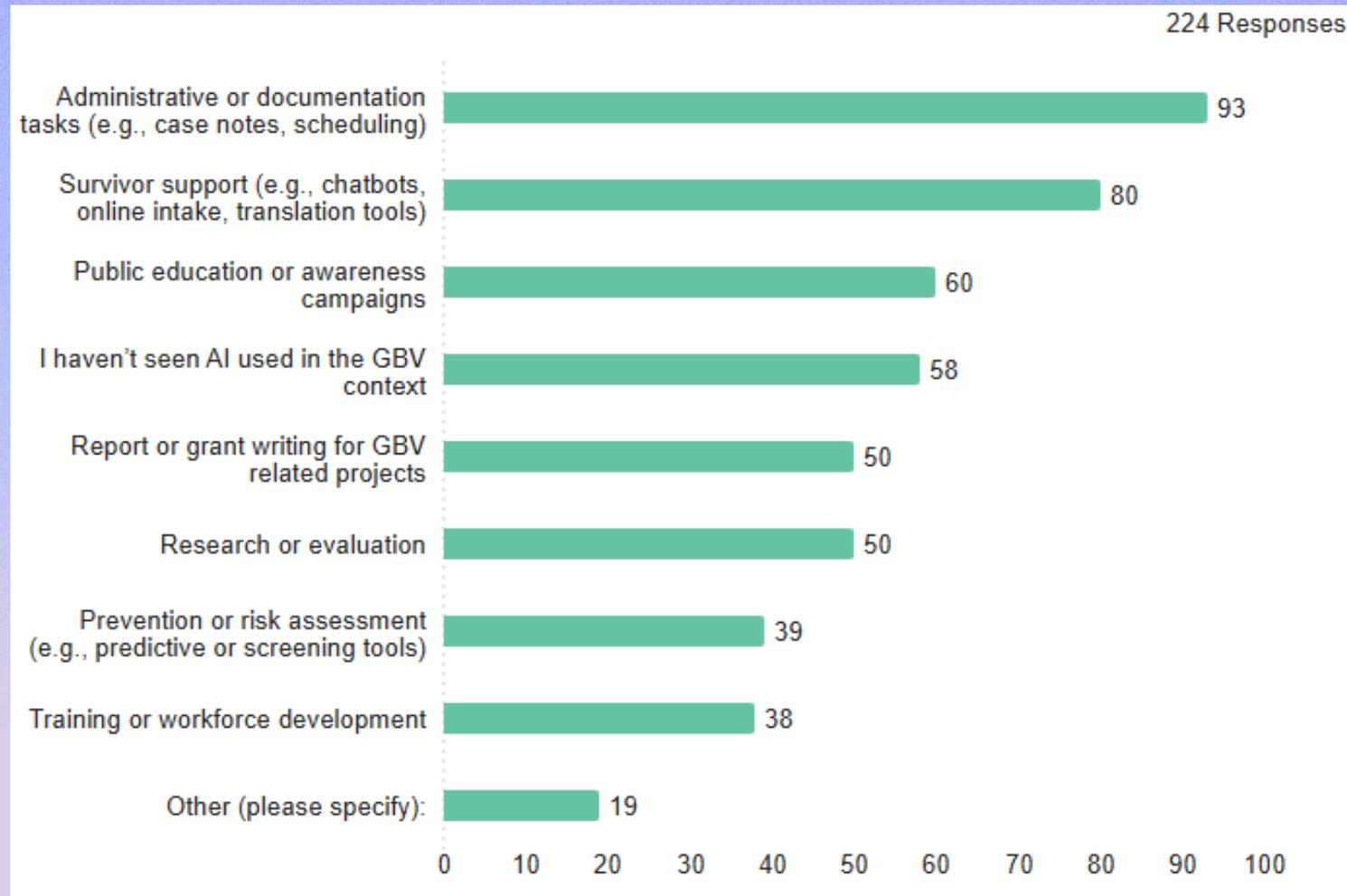
Who Responded to the Survey



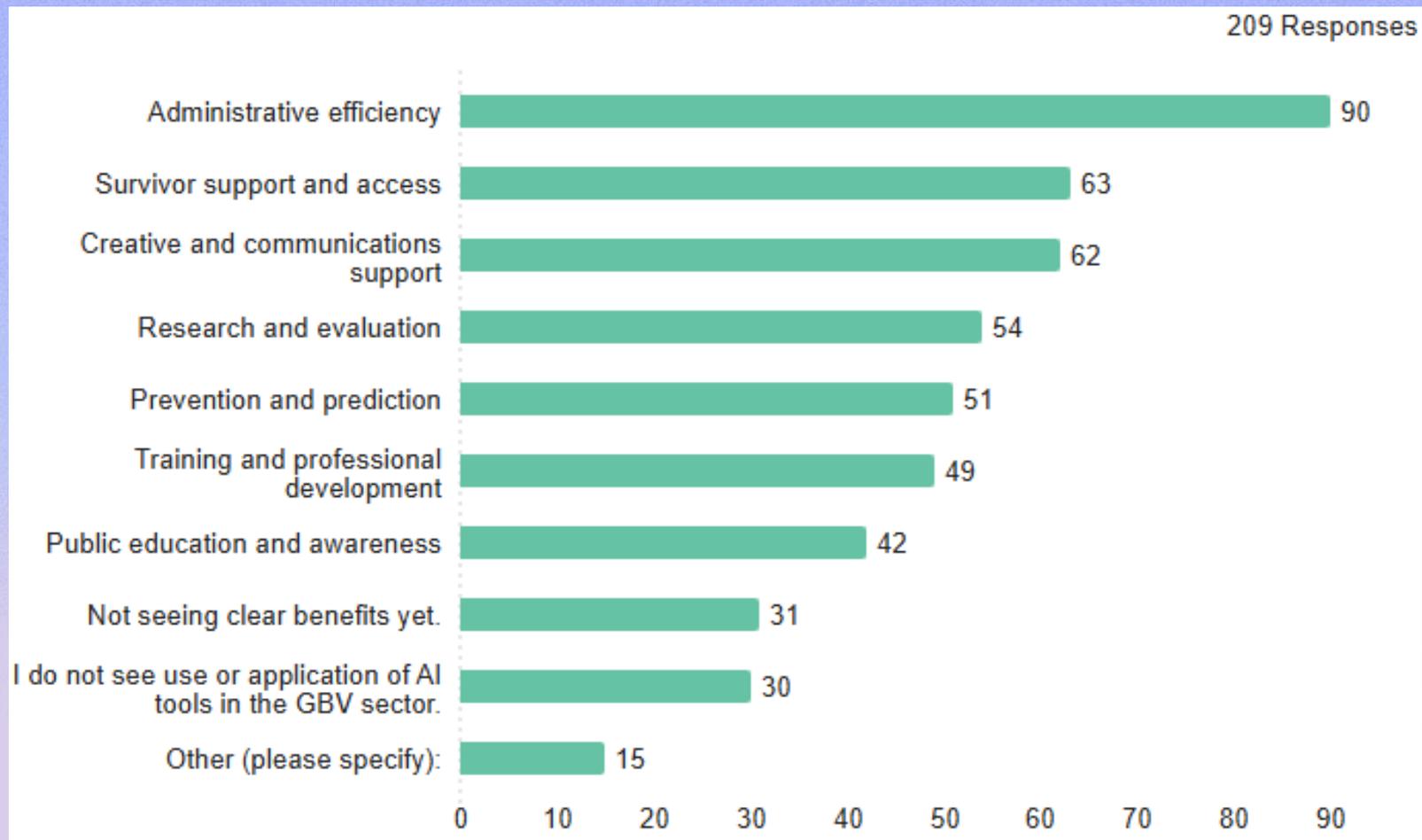
How Respondents Are Navigating AI

- AI is already present in GBV-related work and environments
 - Engagement is uneven and highly context-dependent
 - Decisions about AI are shaped by values, roles and responsibilities
 - Safety, privacy, and equity strongly shape decisions about use

What the Survey Data Tells Us

- AI-related risks are interconnected
- There is no single “right” or “safe” use
- Respondents reported that in their work, they are navigating tension, not seeking simple answers

Conclusion: What this Snapshot Offers

- Insight into how AI is showing up in GBV-related work and environments
 - Often cautiously and selectively
- Respondents emphasized that questions about AI in GBV-related work involve ongoing judgment and are shaped by GBV sector values, roles, and context.
